The visor in your Corvette is attached at the windshield frame with a rotating bezel. In order to remove the visor, you will insert an appropriately-sized flathead screwdriver into the slot on this bezel; turn the visor toward the driver's door. See detailed instructions below.

Step 1.

Flip the visor down as if to block the sun and insert small flat screwdriver into slot on inner bezel of the visor mount. I recommend wrapping the shaft of the screw driver with painters tape because you will actually press the visor arm against it for leverage.

Step 2.

Rotate the visor towards the driver's door while holding the screw driver in the slot and against the arm of the visor. This will cause the inner ring of the bezel to rotate counter clockwise and release.

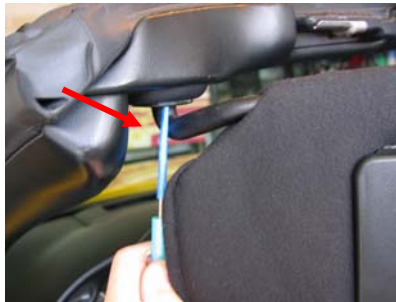

Step 3.

As the visor approaches a 45 degree angle from the windshield, you will feel a "click" and it should begin to slip out of the mounting hole. Gently pull the visor down while continuing to turn; this will expose the two wire connector.

Step 4.

After exposing the connector you must separate the male and female ends. The easiest way to do this is by prying gently on the clip, holding them together while pulling gently.
